MINUTES

Montevallo City Council Work Session October 28, 2013 5:30 p.m. at City Hall

Mayor Hollie Cost, Council Member Dee Woodham, Council Member Rusty Nix, Council Member Willie Goldsmith, and Council Member Don Hughes were in attendance. Council Member Sharon Gilbert was absent.

Mayor Cost called the work session to order at 5:30 p.m. The Mayor informed the council of the need to change the date of the upcoming council meeting from November 11 to November 18 due to the fact City Hall will be closed on the 11th to honor Veteran's Day. She also reminded the council of the Proclamation declaring November as Dyslexia Month. She noted, as well, students from our elementary school will be recognized at the next meeting.

Chief Jeremy Littleton provided the Police Department Report:

Everything is going well with the school resource officer and we are continuing extra patrols in all the schools.

We will have extra patrols Thursday evening for the Trick or Treat on Main Street to ensure there are no problems if it does not get rained out.

Council Member Woodham asked for an update on the junk vehicle in Heritage Trace. The Chief said the property owner has been sent a letter alerting them to the violation. Council

Member Hughes noted there are several inoperable vehicles in the area around the Middle School which need to be removed. He suggested that the cost to remove those vehicles could be included in our CDBG grant. Council Member Woodham agreed. Mayor Cost said there is another meeting scheduled with the residents in that neighborhood and that she would mention it then. Chief Littleton said to let him know the addresses and they would take care of it.

Council Member Goldsmith informed the council about a disturbing Halloween decoration at a home on Hwy 25. Mayor Cost said she talked to the residents and they have moved the display to the backyard. Chief Littleton agreed the display was in poor taste, but he said it was intended as a Halloween display and that the owners have made an effort to work with the city. Thomas Lilly, a resident, said the display still offends him. He said he wants our children to be exposed to good examples in Montevallo. They shouldn't have to see displays like that. The Mayor reiterated they moved the display and tried to make it more apparently Halloween oriented. Mr. Lilly said it still bothers him. Chief Littleton explained there is nothing we can do to force the resident to remove it. Mayor Cost said she has talked to the residents and the landlord, and that we have done everything we can do. The kids who created the Halloween display did not intend for it to be offensive. Nevertheless, they agreed to move the display from the front yard.

Chief Reid reported that the Fire Department was involved in a critical incident stress debriefing last week in order to help the responders cope with the aftermath of the fatal fire they responded to in Wilton. It was a 2 hour session and he thinks our firefighters got a lot out of it. He said he hopes events such as the fire in Wilton don't happen, but it is a potential reality they must constantly deal with.

Council Member Woodham said she spoke to Karen Pendleton at SEA about the possibility of obtaining a smoke detector grant. Chief Reid said he was aware of that and would like to get that program restarted in Montevallo. Council Member Woodham said Mrs. Pendleton hopes to purchase the smoke detectors with the grant monies and have our firefighters install them. She noted, however, there were concerns in the past over the city's potential liability in situations such as that. Chief Reid said he knows of several communities that have programs like this. Several of the communities also offer to install them. Council Member Woodham noted it is important that the homeowner have them installed in the correct locations. She just wants to make certain there is no liability on our part. Chief Reid said we still have several smoke detectors leftover from our previous program. Mayor Cost said we will follow up on that to make sure there are no concerns. She thanked the firefighters for their efforts and said they are doing a great job.

Council Member Hughes said he would like us to perform a review of our street lights to include both burned-out bulbs which need to be replaced and those which have dimmed over time. He said Alabama Power should be able to help us address this problem.

In addition, he mentioned the Arbor Board is in the process of identifying problematic trees throughout the city which are dead and need to be taken down. He said we can then set our priorities and take down those trees as funds are available.

He mentioned, as well, that our street paving priority list has been delivered to Shelby County so they can help us price those improvements. Once we know how much repaving those streets will cost, we can choose which streets we want repaved in an effort to maximize our limited resources. In the meantime, he noted King Street needs several potholes repaired immediately.

H.G McGaughy, a resident, commented that the potholes on King Street were recently repaired and that the city did an excellent job. Kirk Hamby said the street is still rough, but the repairs made a tremendous improvement. The Mayor said we hope to be able to repave roads such as that in the very near future.

Council Member Hughes said he looked at the trees by the High School. They are getting high and need to be trimmed. This should be accomplished during the winter months.

Kirk Hamby informed the council that the drain Allison Welcome complained about has been cleared of debris. Also, the Water Board removed the logs at the Old Mill Dam. The street sign list is being culled to separate those signs which are the responsibility of the city versus the county or state.

Mr. Hamby said there are 5 trees he knows of which need to come down immediately. Mayor Cost said we are looking into the possibility of keeping some of the tree trunks in place so they can be carved by local sculptors. Mr. Hamby said we have one bid already to take down those trees, but he is in the process of requesting additional bids. Council Member Hughes suggested the work be performed over the holidays when school is out. He asked if Mr. Hale had reviewed the list. Mr. Hamby said Mr. Hale has reviewed the list and that he said the trees are dead. Mayor Cost informed the council we are also discussing a replanting program. Council Member Hughes said when we take down a tree we need a way to replace it with a proper tree. He also suggested we work with the adjoining property owners to take certain they are informed of our efforts. Mr. Hamby said that is being done, as well. Council Member Hughes said the bid list should go to the City Clerk and then to the council. Mayor Cost said we need to get this done as soon as possible.

Mayor Cost then recognized guests from the Middle and High Schools.

Mayor Cost presented the High School and Middle School with contributions from the city. She noted that, thanks to the urging of Council Member Hughes, the council was able to increase the amount it was able to contribute this year from \$500 to \$1,050. The Elementary School will also receive the same contribution of \$1,050.

Opportunities for citizens to speak to the Council

Committee Reports and Consideration of Bills:

Public Health & Safety (Police, Fire, Code Enforcement, Housing Abatement) - Discussed earlier.

Sustainability (Streets & Sanitation, Recycling, Arbor & Beautification, ValloCycle, Environmental Preservation Initiatives) – Discussed earlier.

Recreation, Preservation and Community Development (Parks & recreation, Golf Course, Youth Athletics, Trails, Historical Commission, Planning & Zoning, Annexations) –

Council Member Nix said Critters by the Creek was a huge success with over 500 participants.

Council Member Woodham informed the council we have two people who have donated benches at Orr Park in honor of someone. She said this would be a good thing to do in other locations, as well, such as the Promenade and Library Garden. The Mayor asked Mr. Hamby to talk to the Park Board about where we should place those benches.

Ed Davis provided the following Golf Course Report:

My goal is to increase Cart and Green Fee income while decreasing payroll as one way to contribute towards creating a profit for Montevallo Golf Club for 2013-14 golf year.

Enclosed please find the analysis on Cart and Green fee income for October 2013 as compared to October 2012. Also included you will find payroll expenses for October 2013 as compared to October 2012. We are running promotions to increase income from Cart/G.fees and are cutting payroll to bare minimums.

- 1. Our total rounds from Oct. 1 Oct. 27th have increased, due to promotions, from 1043 rounds in Oct. 2012 to 1129 rounds in Oct. 2013, an increase of 86 rounds, a nice increase of 7.7% the first 27 days of Oct. 2013.
- 2. Rounds are nice, but revenue is better, and our income from Oct. 1-Oct. 27th have increased, due to promotions, from \$17,110 generated from Cart/G.fees in October 2012 to \$19,624 generated from C./G.fees in Oct. 2013, an increase of \$2,514, and a very nice 12.9% increase in revenues from C/G.fees.
- 3. Payroll periods for Montevallo Golf Club in Oct. 2012 totaled \$18560 while payroll in Oct. 2013 totaled \$14926, a decrease in payroll of \$3,634, a very nice reduction of payroll of 19.6% over last October.
- 4. Montevallo Golf Club wrote checks to the City of Montevallo totaling \$29,754, and reduced the amount owed to the City of Montevallo by approximately \$14,828 for the month of October 2013.

Council Member Hughes informed the council he attended the last Golf Board meeting. He is working to locate possible equipment donations to help the course in an effort to reduce costs. In addition, we have a lawnmower at the City which can be loaned to the Golf Board in the event their mower needs repair. That too should help save them money. With the growing season coming to an end, we should have plenty of time to find some equipment for them.

Council Member Nix said our baseball fields should be in good shape in time for the next season. Mayor Cost noted we are talking about holding registration elsewhere because our fields will be under construction this winter.

Council Member Woodham asked if the fields which have been dedicated have signs on them. Mr. Hamby said they did but they are gone and we need to replace them. Mayor Cost said we will do that.

Council Member Nix said our trails are in good shape. He did note, however, that the graffiti is back up under the bridge.

As far as the Historical Commission is concerned, Council Member Nix said they are still working on their trail map. In addition, he said they have yet to identify a surveyor for the old cemetery. He wondered if the county may have a surveyor that could assist us. The Mayor said she wasn't sure. Most of the projects we are involved with county on, like Stephens Park, have required hiring an outside surveyor.

Council Member Hughes mentioned that the Sustainability Committee has looked into the need to put a sealcoat on the subdivisions. Council Member Woodham said she would like to see the Planning Commission look at the situation and recommend ways to address this situation. The City Clerk suggested the council has the authority to make a decision in that regard without input from the Planning Commission. The Planning Commission already discussed the issue and addressed it to the best of their knowledge in the new Subdivision Regulations. Mayor Cost suggested we discuss this in more detail with Shelby County.

Education, Arts & Outreach (Schools, UM, Boys & Girls Club, Library, American Village, Sister City Commission, Artwalk, Middle School Grant) –

In the absence of Council Member Gilbert, Mayor Cost presented her Education Report:

Education, Arts and Outreach Committee:

Montevallo Elementary School will have MES Night at the Main Street Tavern on Tuesday, November 5th. Please stop by to support the elementary school. The PTO will receive 10% of your total bill.

MES will have a Liberty/Veteran's Day Program on November 8th at 9:00 a.m. All veterans, police officers and firemen will be recognized. The location will be announced at a later date. Please contact a member of the PTO with names of veterans in the community. Ms. Jennifer Macomb is coordinating the event.

Also, the MES PTO will have a Christmas Bazaar on November 21 from 5:00 - 8:00 p.m.

Montevallo Fligh School Marching Troubadours earned ALL superior ratings along with the Best in Class Award at the Hayden Band Competition. In addition, out of 20 bands in the entire contest, the Troubadours finished second overall with a band score average of 95.33.

The University of Montevallo is featured in a book written by Peter Arango entitled, <u>America's Best Kept College Secrets</u>, published by CreateSpace Publishing in Los Angeles, CA.

The Sister City Commission met tonight. I will provide an update at the next Council meeting.

Art Stalk was held on Saturday. According to Courtney Bennett, the event went well.

The Dailey Park Neighborhood Projects are as follows: Open bids for road, sewer, streets, and sidewalk improvements are due November 13 with the start of construction on January 6th. Open bids for the housing/structure demolition was October 8th with the start of construction on November 1st.

Allie Williams provided a brief Library Report. Trick-or-Treat at the Library is from 4-6 p.m. on Thursday. Everyone is invited to participate, especially if it rains. There were 2,287 visits to the city website since October 14th.

Council Member Woodam noted that a citizen had complained about sign violations: one at the new furniture store and the other at the Pawn Shop on Main St. The City Clerk said he would report those to our enforcement staff.

Finance, Economic Development & Tourism (Finance, MDCD, IDB, Chamber) -

Council Member Woodham informed everyone the Chamber of Commerce has appointed a new director – Steve Gilbert.

The MDCD has received a draft of the hotel feasibility study and is working to make corrections.

Shelby County is assisting us with the planned improvements at Stephens Park. Mayor Cost mentioned that the work will be completed in phases so as to not disrupt the season. The concession stand work should be completed this winter before the next season begins. Work on the fields will take place after the season ends. We will have improved bathrooms, a new roof, locker rooms, etc.

Debby Raymond informed everyone that we are now processing our business licenses back at City Hall. Renewals will go out in November.

Council Member Nix asked if there is a timeline on when we will have a new business at the old Coach Company. Council Member Woodham said there is not, it has been a slow process. There are four proposals the MMDCD is currently considering.

Council Member Nix made a motion to approve payment of the bills. Council Member Goldsmith seconded. ALL AYES . . . MOTION APPROVED.

Council Member reminded everyone that the Finance Committee meeting will be Wednesday, 4:30 p.m. at City Hall.

Council Member Hughes reminded the mayor about the storage building next to the Middle School which is out of code. He suggested we need to check with Council Member Gilbert about that.

Also, the lights and fencing from the old ball field at Orr Park have been saved and are stored at the Recycling Center in the event we have a future need for them.

He also mentioned that UM has started construction on their new soccer fields. The old field will house the new public track facility we are helping them to develop.

In response to a question from Council Member Hughes, Council Member Woodham confirmed that the MDCD has its loan finalized and funding is in place for our projects. Council Member Hughes asked what the final total we borrowed was. He said the last he could recall we were going to borrow approximately \$4.5 million. Council Member Woodham said the final project list approved by the council was closer to \$5 million and she would be happy to get him another copy of that list.

Mayor Cost said she would like approval to address the removal of the problem trees identified by Mr. Hamby at a cost of no more than \$5,000, subject to final review of the bids by the Mayor

and City Clerk. Council Member Hughes made a motion to that affect. Council Member Nix seconded. ALL AYES... MOTION APPROVED.

Citizen Participation

Julie Smitherman asked if there was a back-up plan for the city Trick-or-Treat celebration. The Mayor said people can go to the library if the event on Main Street is rained out and suggested she take their candy there.

Ms. Smitherman asked if the city has a way to have graffiti cleaned of privately owned buildings. Also, she asked if the police could set up cameras to take photos of the perpetrators. Chief Littleton said businesses should notify his office if they are having problems and that we will work with them to catch the offenders.

Ms. Smitherman asked if there had been any progress on the new code revisions. Mayor Cost informed her we are reviewing the proposed changes internally and will have the proposed changes completed soon. After that, she will present the proposal to an ad hoc, citizens committee for their further review and comment.

Ed Davis asked how we can go about getting a copy of the approved project list. Mayor Cost said she would have it added to our website.

The Mayor also noted we are investigating a new city App.

Mr. Davis asked if any of the paving funds could be used at the Golf Course. Mayor Cost said she has talked with Shelby County about our needs at the Golf Course.

Council Member Woodham noted that the proposal includes, among other things, \$1.5 million for paving.

Donald Hartman, a resident of Hidden Forest, said the roads at the rear of the subdivision needs a lot of work. The Mayor explained we have a list of paving needs throughout the city and we will prioritize projects based on that list. Council Member Hughes said that is also why we asked Shelby County to provide us with cost estimates based on the improvements which needed to be made to each road.

Mr. Hartman also mentioned that Hidden Forest Drive has a speeding problem on it. Chief Littleton informed him we had our officers on that road this week checking for speeding. Mr.

Hartman said there have been a lot of near misses with children on that road and it needs more intensive patrols. Mayor Cost suggested speed bumps. Mr. Hartman declined this indicating that might negatively impact property values.

Kirk Hamby informed the council that Steve Gilbert had texted him to let him know he would not be able to attend the meeting and to extend his apologies.

There being no other business before the council, Council Member Nix made a motion to adjourn. Council Member Goldsmith seconded. ALL AYES . . . MEETING ADJOURNED at 6:59 p.m.
