Design Committee:

Committee Chair, Kirk Lightfoot, reported that the committee will install a display at the post office photo frame area in April for child abuse prevention awareness month in conjunction with Owen's House and other Main Street communities in Shelby County; Facade Grant projects are underway at Falcon Art and The Type Shop, with Montevallo Realty's now complete; thanks again to the City of Montevallo for designating ARPA funds for replacement bows, garland, and banners for downtown at Christmas; plans are underway as to how we can show more school spirit downtown during UM's homecoming/College Night week next year; preparation for the May 5 tour as part of the Main Street Now conference is still underway; the Festival of Tulips ended Monday, experiencing record turnout; a committee is being formed to plan a Monte Gras fundraising event for February 2025; discussion was had regarding providing refreshments for Public Works in thanks for their hard work.

Promotion Committee:

Committee Chair, Sarah Hogan, reported that committee members completed a survey to assess current activities and suggest new ones, including new promotional items; members have been assigned to work plans; spring Bulldog sports posters have been printed and will be distributed by Patricia and Jacqueline to local businesses this week; thanks to Adele for working with American Village regarding the Blooming Bargains promotion, adding new signage this year, and thanks to participating businesses; thanks also to Adele for donating lights to add to the tulip tire display at 747 Main; sponsors are being sought for Friday Nights at the Cove (4 opportunities to sponsor at \$750/event); a spring scavenger hunt is tentatively planned for May 24; plans will be made to celebrate Montevallo Main Street's 8th Anniversary in June; partnership is ongoing with Alabama Public Television regarding a youth entrepreneurship event planned for a June Farmers' Market.



Economic Vitality Committee:

Committee Chair, Ken Jones, reported that the committee is preparing for the May 5 Main Street Now tour; CO.STARTERS begins August 27 and applications are now being accepted; the committee is a sponsor of Arts Fest and Team Lehman/SEA Disc Golf Tournament; all are encouraged to vote for Shelby Living's Best of the Best; the weekend of April 20-21 will bring thousands of visitors to Montevallo, and board members are encouraged to let business owners about this since it is an opportunity for us to give visitors a good (or a bad) impression as a community with how well businesses are staffed and how litter-free downtown is on that weekend.
