- Another idea, host a night time glow party. Parks could provide glow sticks and related glow items. (If approved by the Shoal Creek Planning Committee, new action item)
- We will need to have volunteers to manage parking, tube retrieval and other event related activities. Jim and Curt stated they can gather help form UMSGA and the Exercise Science club. (If approved by the Shoal Creek Planning Committee, new action item)

Topic 3: Dog Park

- Research has been done on constructing a dog park in Montevallo. Paul will continue researching possible grants
- The idea will be presented to the City Council at an upcoming Council meeting
- We learned there are resources at city hall that could help with grant writing and project coordination
