Old Business:

Waiting for a quote. The city wants to repair gutters, lights, plumbing, hot water heater before beginning the Children's Area Fire Door Exit with the grant awarded by the ALA Disabilities Grant which expires in the spring.

New Business:

TAB – Teen Advisory Board interest meeting set for 2/27. This is for parents and teens, with Jodie running this group. Teens could earn volunteer hours.
